

State Route 619 Corridor Study

About the Project

State Route 619 (West Turkeyfoot Lake Road) is a key corridor in New Franklin's growing Portage Lakes region, where planned residential development and increasing traffic highlight the need for updated infrastructure. Currently a two-lane road with no sidewalks, bike facilities, or lighting, SR 619 sees high vehicle and pedestrian use. This study will guide improvements to support multimodal transportation and future growth, building on recent investments in intersection upgrades and sewer and water extensions.

What is a Corridor Study?

A Corridor Study helps communities improve how people move through and experience key transportation corridors by focusing on:

- **Connectivity & Safety** | Smoother, safer travel
- **Community Character** | Strengthening identity & sense of place
- **Economic Vitality** | Supporting business & investment
- **Future Planning** | Guiding smart growth & infrastructure

Why Plan Now?

Planning now is critical as the SR 619 Corridor has been identified as a priority in the 2023 Comprehensive Plan, which calls for improvements to support commercial growth, traffic, and land use management. With funding from AMATS, the current study is focused on enhancing safety and non-motorized connectivity to create a vibrant, accessible, and sustainable district. In addition, the planned extension of water and sewer services and the advancement of the Point Comfort development make this a timely opportunity to guide future growth and infrastructure improvements.

Project Focus

- Plan for **pedestrian and bicycle safety and connectivity**
- Prepare for increased traffic impact at **intersection of Point Comfort Dr & SR 619**
- Integrate **future development** on Point Comfort Dr
- Strategize for **space limitations** at SR 619 Bridge over channel
- Review **access management** strategy



The study area is bounded by the New Franklin/Green Corporation limit to the East, New Franklin/corporation limit to the north, State Street to the west, and Turkeyfoot Lake to the south. Main emphasis of study is the SR 619 corridor and the SR 619/South Turkeyfoot Road/Point Comfort Drive intersection.
