RE: Weaver Woodlands Remediation

Greetings,

You are receiving this correspondence because you either live in, or nearby, the EPA remediation areas which were designated following the discovery of a BP pipeline failure in 1990. Many of you have been involved with and/or are conversant with the remediation steps taken to date. You may also have recently received notice of an EPA Public Meeting which was scheduled for June 11<sup>th</sup> to advise of further proceedings.

At the City's request, the Public Meeting of June 11<sup>th</sup> has been cancelled and rescheduled for July 17<sup>th</sup> at 6pm at Grace Church, 5781 Manchester Road. The extension was requested so that we could direct everyone to the resources provided by BP and the EPA to assist you in better understanding the issues and the remedial alternatives being considered. All of this will be more fully presented and discussed at the Public Hearing to be conducted by the EPA on July 17<sup>th</sup>.

Enclosed is a copy of the EPA Fact Sheet containing historic details, current remedial alternatives, and the EPA's Preferred Plan.
